(57) **CLAIM**

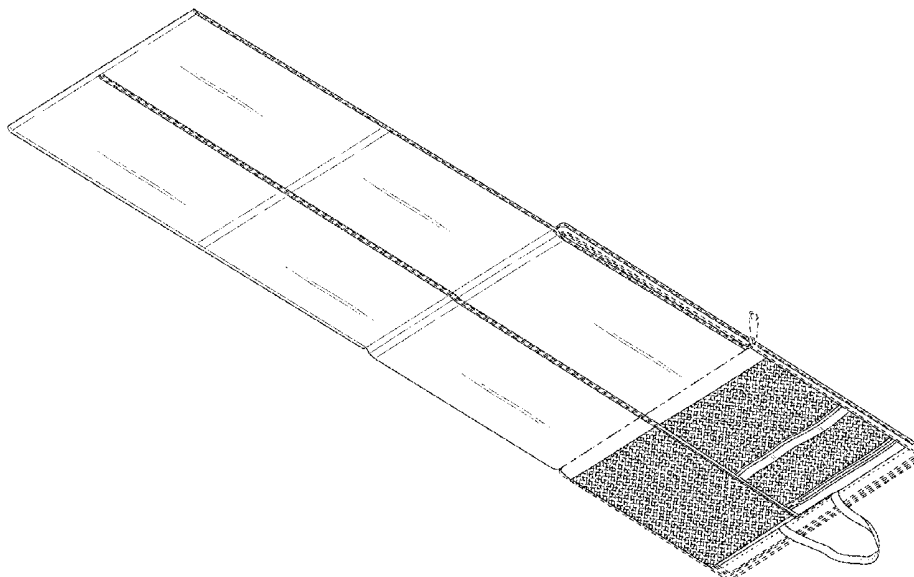
The ornamental design for a garment bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front left side perspective view of a garment bag showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.

The broken lines show portions of the garment bag that form no part of the claimed design. The dash-dot-dash broken lines define a boundary of the claimed design and form no part thereof.

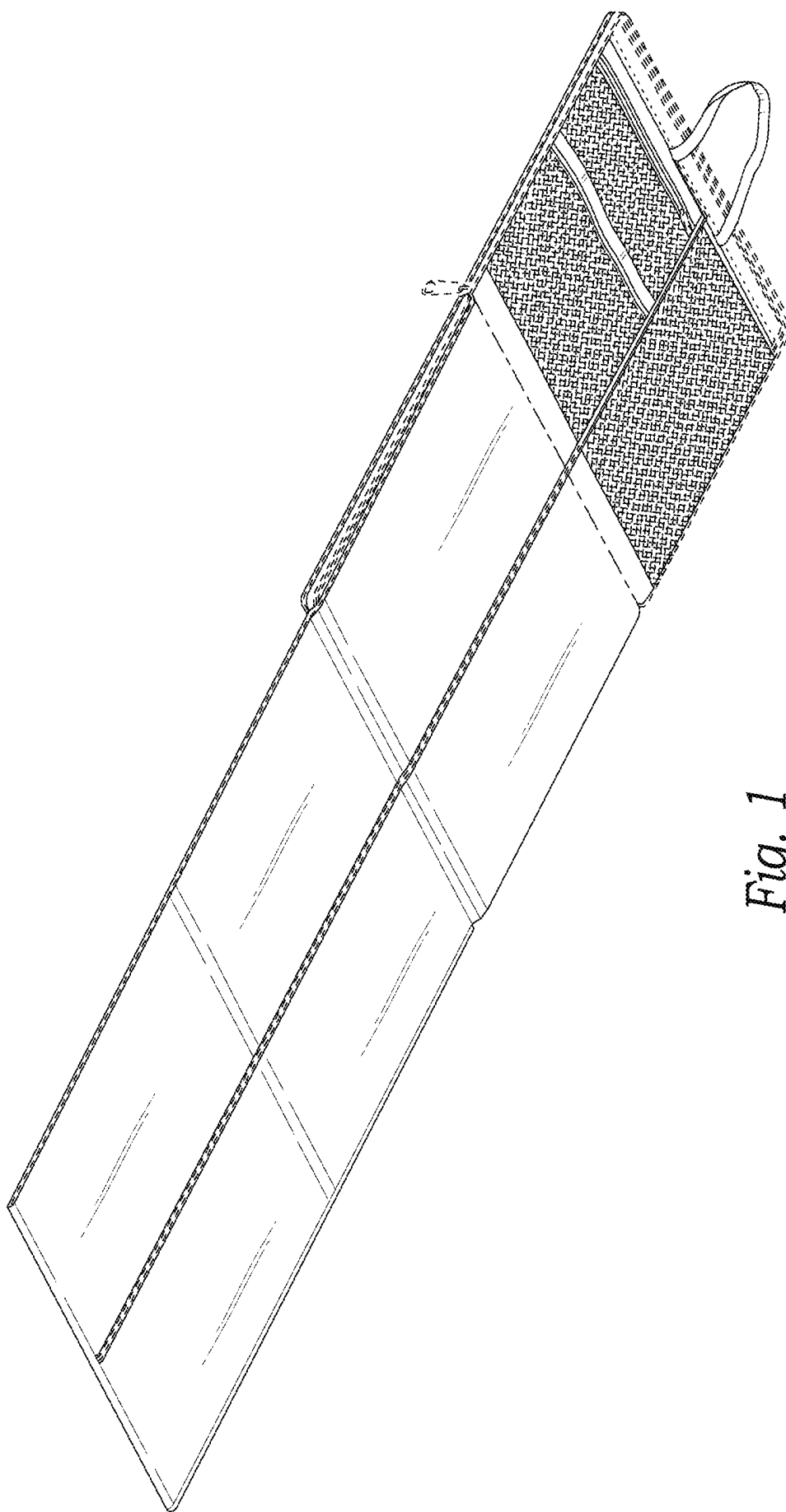

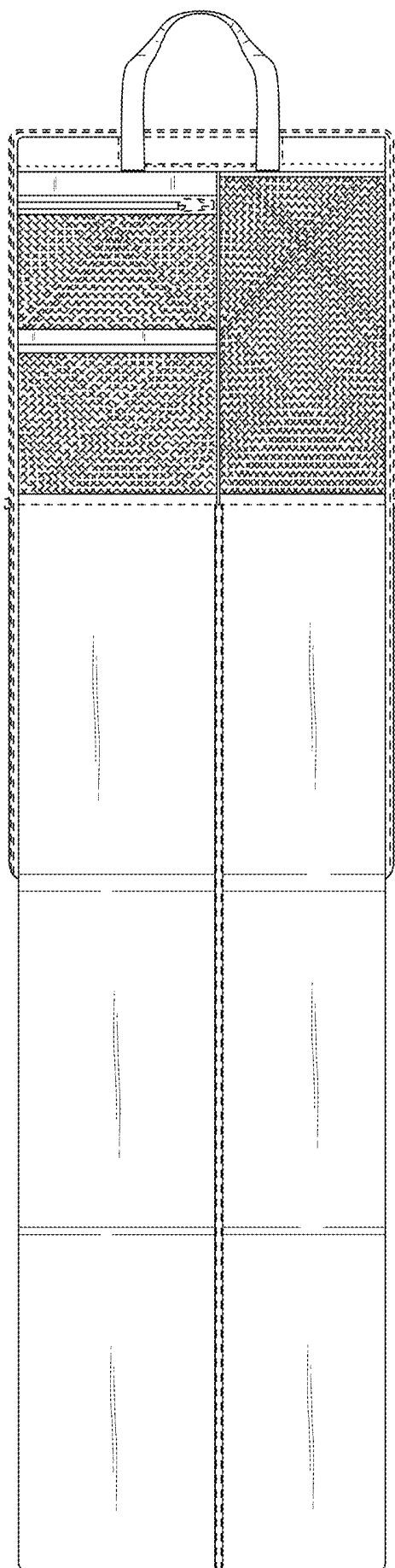
